Further Requirements	
(i.e. Language Aptitude, Test Recognition)	Germany has automatic recognition of migrants from other EU (European Union) countries, but the authorities reserve the right to prove individual cases. Adaptation periods are sometimes required. If the equivalence of diplomas is not at hand the comparability of knowledge in physiotherapy has to be demonstrated through an aptitude test. Knowledge of the host country's language is necessary. To become a member of the German Physiotherapy Association the migrant must have a recognised diploma.
